## SHENDISH MANOR HOTEL & GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

White tees are only for members use and restricted to when competing in a Club competition.

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

- a) 13th & 18th Holes – On or beyond the road.
- b) Area to the right of the 9th and 16th and beyond the 14th green.
- c) Beyond the line of any boundary hedge, fence, white post or line of white stakes acting as a boundary to the course.

### 2. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Staked trees are deemed immovable obstructions and relief MUST be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1 when stance or area of intended swing is interfered with by such trees. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted. All hard surface paths should be treated as an immovable obstruction and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1.

### 3. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them is permitted with Rule 16.1. If the head either on or within two clubs of the green in play, interferes with the line of play towards the hole, relief without penalty can be available as follows: - the ball is not on the green and not in the hazard, but is two club lengths of the interfering obstruction, it can be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where it lay. This is a) no nearer the hole, b) avoids the interference, c) is not in a hazard and d) not on the putting green.

### 4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1)

Tracks and ruts made by the course maintenance equipment and construction vehicles may be treated as ground under repair. Temporary greens, once prepared and not in play, should be treated as ground under repair and relief be taken in compliance of Rule 16.1.

### 5. BUNKERS

All loose impediments may be removed from the bunkers without penalty. (Rule 15.1). However, if the ball is moved or lifted a penalty applies (Rule 2.2)

### 6. SUSPENSION OF PLAY/ DANGEROUS WEATHER

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by one prolonged note of the siren. All other suspensions will be signalled by three consecutive notes of the siren. In either case, resumption of play will be signalled by two short notes of the siren. See Rule 5.7b

### 7. ALTERNATIVE TO STROKE & DISTANCE FOR LOST BALL OR BALL OUT OF BOUNDS, FOR NON-QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS ONLY.

When a player's ball has not been found or is believed discovered to be out of bounds, for two penalty strokes, the player may drop in the relief area, no nearer the hole, rather than returning to replay the shot. (Rule 14.3). This is only available if a provisional ball has not been played.

### 8. TEMPORARY RULE WHEN WINTER RULES IS DISPLAYED.

A ball lying on any "closely mown area" on the course may, without penalty, be lifted, cleaned and placed within six inches of where it originally lay, but not nearer the hole. The position of the ball must be marked before the ball is lifted. After the ball is replaced, it is in play.

#### ETIQUETTE: -

- 1. Remember to replace divots, repair pitch marks, and rake bunkers after use.
- 2. Show consideration to others by playing at a prompt pace, not distracting golfers in play and with yours and others safety in mind.
- 3. With integrity by following the rules, applying all penalties and being honest.
